

## **Ministry with Emmanuel Students**

The following is a comprehensive guide for serving in the Emmanuel Students ministry. This guide outlines expectations, procedures, and key practices to ensure a safe, structured, and impactful environment.

#### **General Requirements**

- Love for Students: Volunteers must genuinely love and care for students.
- **Background Checks**: All volunteers in children's/student ministries must pass a background check.
- **Membership Requirement**: Volunteers must be members of Emmanuel for at least six months and in good standing.
- Child Protection Guidelines:
  - o Never raise your voice or strike a child.
  - A leader may never be alone with a child.
  - o A leader may **never** private message a child of the opposite sex.

### **General Information and Instructions**

- Check-In Process:
  - Assist with student check-in if necessary.
  - o Maintain a roll of students at all gatherings.
  - o Ask parents if the child has any allergies.
- Program Structure:
  - o Include both large and small group times for discipleship using curriculum approved by church leadership.
  - o Provide time for activities to foster friendship, camaraderie, and enjoyment.

# **Behavior Management**

- Handling Misbehavior:
  - o Do not raise your voice with students.



- Never strike a child.
- Use positive reinforcement whenever possible.

### • Intervention Procedure:

- o Take the student aside to discuss their behavior away from the group.
- If misbehavior persists, contact the student's parents or guardians. Document the incident and provide a copy to the Ministry Director for filing with the Executive Pastor.

- o Inform the parents of the incident upon pickup.

## **Non-Medical Emergencies**

#### • Evacuation Protocol:

- o Take the check-in roll to ensure every student is accounted for.
- Vacate via the closest exit.
- o Assemble in the designated emergency meeting place (playground).
- o Once assembled, recheck the roll and await further instructions.



# **Transportation**

- Vehicle Requirements:
  - o Must have current registration and state inspection.
  - Must have enough safety belts for individuals under 18 years of age (per NH State Law).
  - o Must be insured and free of known safety concerns.

## **End of Service**

- Student Dismissal:
  - o Remove the student's name from the check-in roll and verify they have been picked up by an approved guardian.
- Cleanup:
  - o Vacuum carpets as needed after the service.
